- Purpose of the initiative
- Planning
- Implementation
- Limitations or practical implications (if applicable)
- Possible improvements

The proposals will be evaluated by a panel, based on the following criteria:

- The relevance of the initiative(s) for a wider audience
- The potential significance of these changes to e-library development in Singapore
- Clarity of expression

The date for notification of successful proposals:

Monday 24 August 2009.

More detailed guidelines will be given to the successful proposers.

At the seminar, paper presentations should be no more than 20 minutes in length, allowing time for questions from the audience.

It is intended that one copy of the posters will be available in the Pod for viewing by delegates during the seminar. A second set of posters will feature at the Fair site. Poster discussion is scheduled at the Fair site at the conclusion of the seminar.
